Do you have a Fortress Mentality ?

Are you living in fear of being robbed? Sure, take precautions, but don't go to extreme measures, just use your common sense. It's a lot more economical!

House burglaries are most often the result of a good opportunity rather than bad luck. Have you looked at your house from the point of view of a potential burglar?

What can you see that needs to be remedied? Ground floor doors & windows are old favorites for burglars, so why not start with them?

Recent burglaries have seen doors and windows broken, so why not get two new solid doors for a start, one at front and one at the back. Having both professionally fitted, with deadlocks front and back makes a good start.

Then fit steel fly wire doors front and back as well, to make it harder to get to the timber doors ?

And, while your at it, get the windows fitted with good quality locks by a reputable locksmith, with all locks keyed with one key to suit all your timber and fly wire doors too!

Powder coated decorative wrought iron steel window grills, professionally fitted to the inside of window cavities are another way to prevent determined burglars from entering your home.

Unbreakable glass or unbreakable acrylic panels are another alternative to deter entry into your home. Remember, the more noise your burglar makes trying to break in to your house, the better chance of him being caught red handed. There is no substitute for a pair of eyes... 👁 👁
